

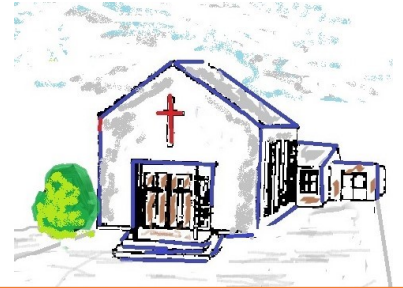

Queen Street church was also recognised as being a part of the United Reformed Church South Lincolnshire Resource Area. We were joined by folk from Westgate New Church (who had also voted positively to the ecumenical partnership arrangement) and representatives from the Methodist Circuit and URC Resource Area congregations, as well as from some of our fellow town churches here in Whittlesey. Rev Sarah Gower, herself operating in an ecumenical partnership at Christchurch Orton Goldhay, gave a wonderful sermon and the URC Moderator Rev Geoffrey Clarke led proceedings with Methodist District Chair Rev Dr Sonia Hicks and our Circuit Superintendent Rev Colin Sherwood also taking part. Rev Colin looks forward to continuing to minister in different areas in the life of our church with Rev Clare in the new model of ecumenical sharing the trustees have been working on with them.

As we move into June the trustees are expectant that the funding for our Youth & Community Worker will be in place so the recruitment process can begin for the much needed professional support of our FoG young people and leaders. Similarly our chapel building repair work should have the funding agreed so we can then place the order with the contractor for the work to be scheduled. Our appeal for our anniversary gift day on June 14th is for your continued generosity in enabling our church to invest in our young people and the buildings for our worship and mission - thank you.
